GHLA attorneys practice in areas including Housing, Family, Benefits, Employment, Education, Senior and Immigration. They appear in state and federal courts at both the trial and appellate level, and before administrative agencies. Staff attorneys also work on systemic advocacy efforts, including impact litigation and policy advocacy.

- Member of Connecticut Bar preferred, or eligibility to waive in or sit for the July 2023 CT Bar Exam
- Superior oral and written communication skills
- Excellent administrative and organizational skills, including ability to self-direct

 - self-motivation, strong work ethic and commitment to working as a team,
 - ability to work effectively with diverse groups and individuals.
